YOUR RIGHTS:

- The right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment
- The right to be free from retaliation for reporting an incident of sexual abuse or sexual harassment
- The right to have a report of sexual abuse or sexual harassment taken seriously and investigated
- The right to outside victim advocate for emotional support services related to sexual abuse

WHAT IS SEXUAL ABUSE?

- Sexual contact involving two or more people when at least one person does not consent.
- Sexual contact also includes:
 - Sexual fondling
 - Sexual assault with an object
 - Oral sex
- Consent is not present if:
 - Sexual contact is forced or against the person's will
 - There is fear or threat of physical violence or bodily injury
 - The victim is by law too young or mentally or physically incapable of consenting

WHAT IS SEXUAL HARASSMENT?

- Repeated unwelcomed sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or verbal comments, gestures or actions of a sexual nature by one resident to another
- Sexual comments or gestures as described above by staff to a resident

WHAT IS VOYUERISM?

- Peering at an individual while performing bodily functions
- Requiring an individual to expose their buttocks or genitals
- And/or photographing an individual during any of the above

WHAT IS PREA?

The prison Rape Elimination Act of September 4, 2003 (Public Law 108-79) was enacted by Congress to address the problem of sexual assault in all U.S. penal facilities.

PREA supports the elimination, reduction, and prevention of sexual assault / rape within our facilities. PREA applies to resident-on-resident and staff-on-resident sexual misconduct.
